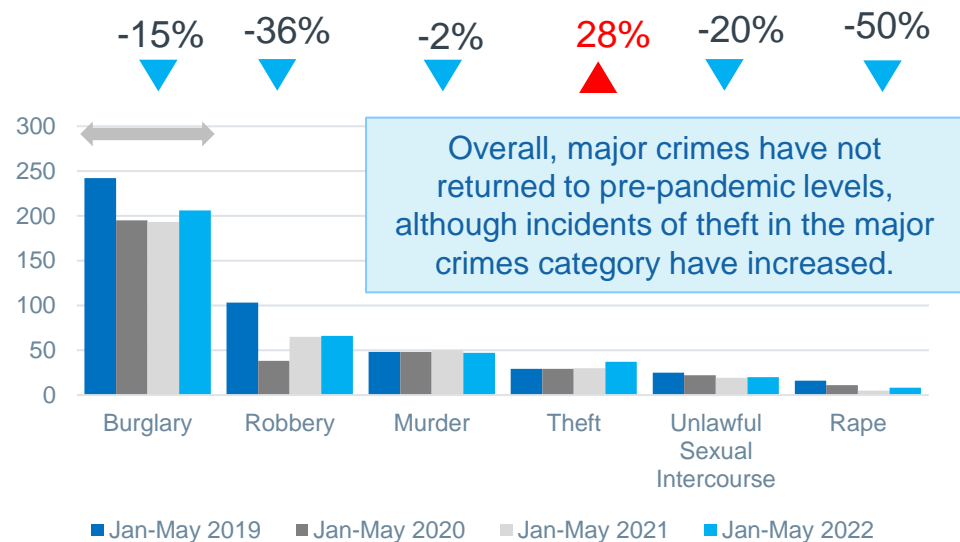
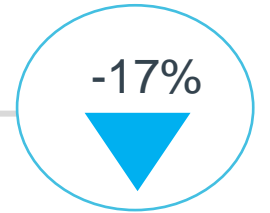
Change in Major Crimes

(First 5 months, 2019 vs 2022)

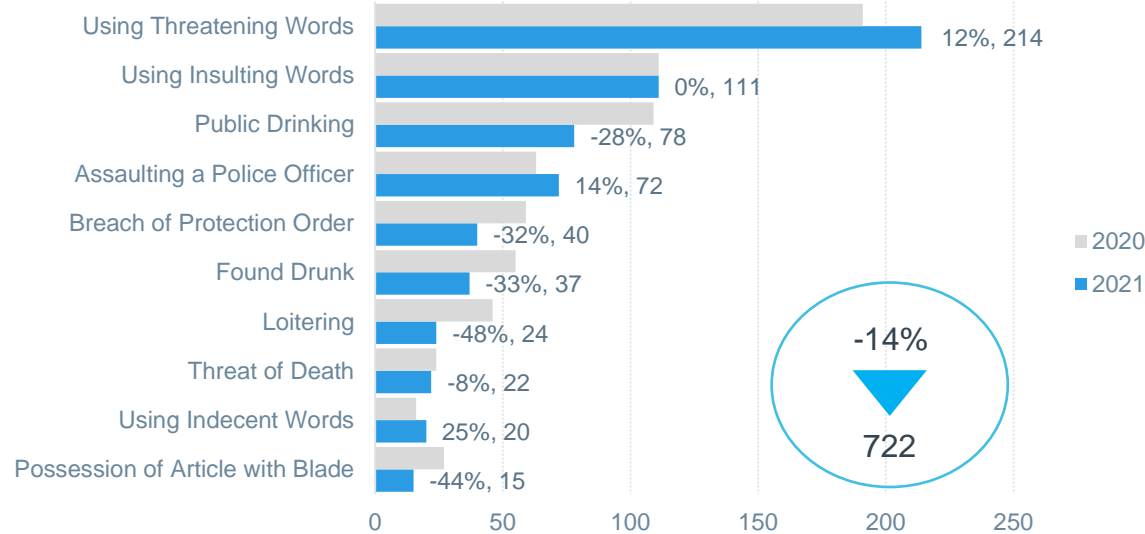


Overall, major crimes have not returned to pre-pandemic levels, although incidents of theft in the major crimes category have increased.

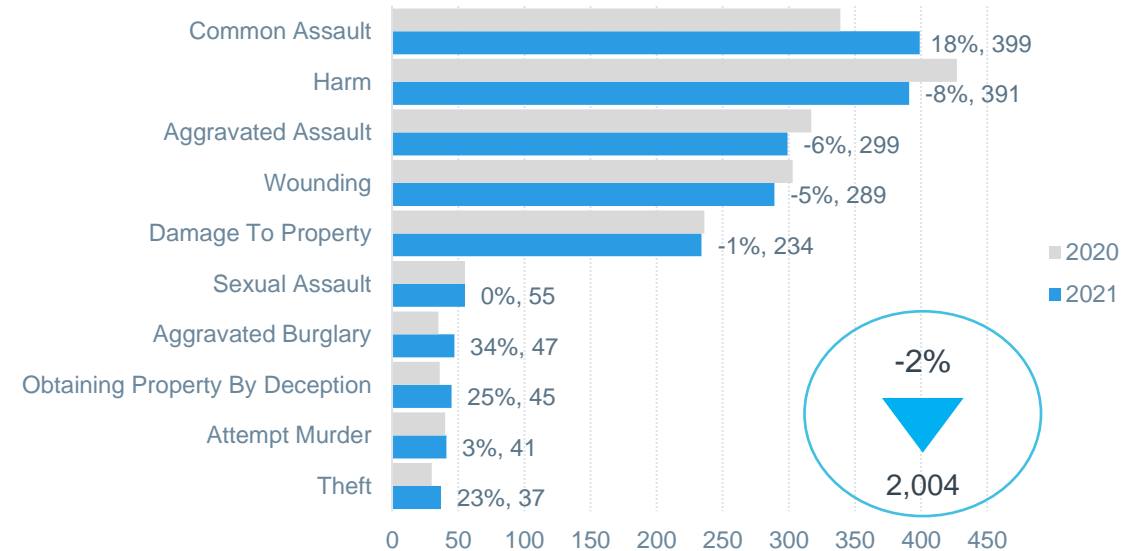
Absolute change and percent change, 2021 vs 2020

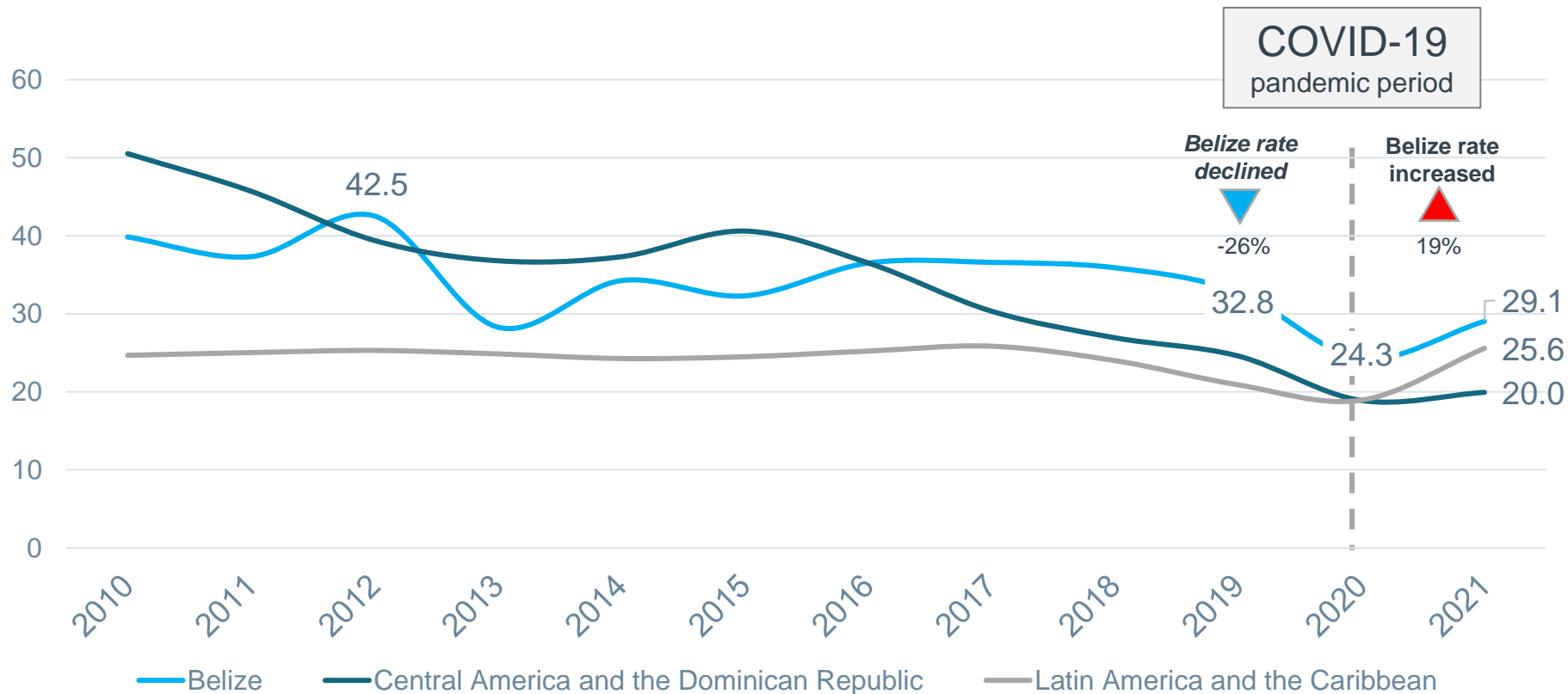

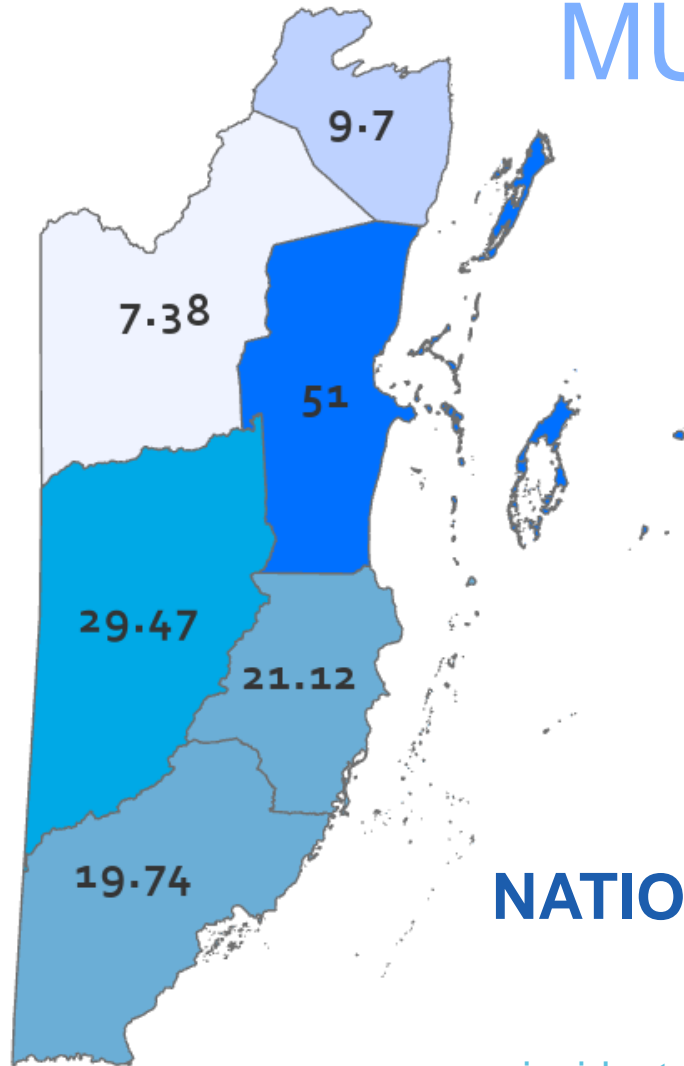

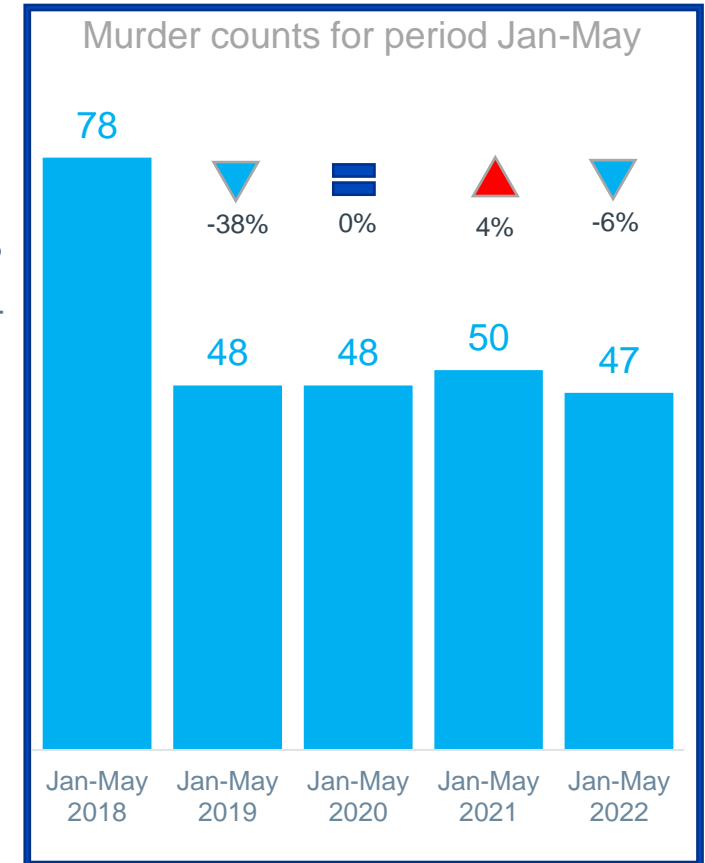
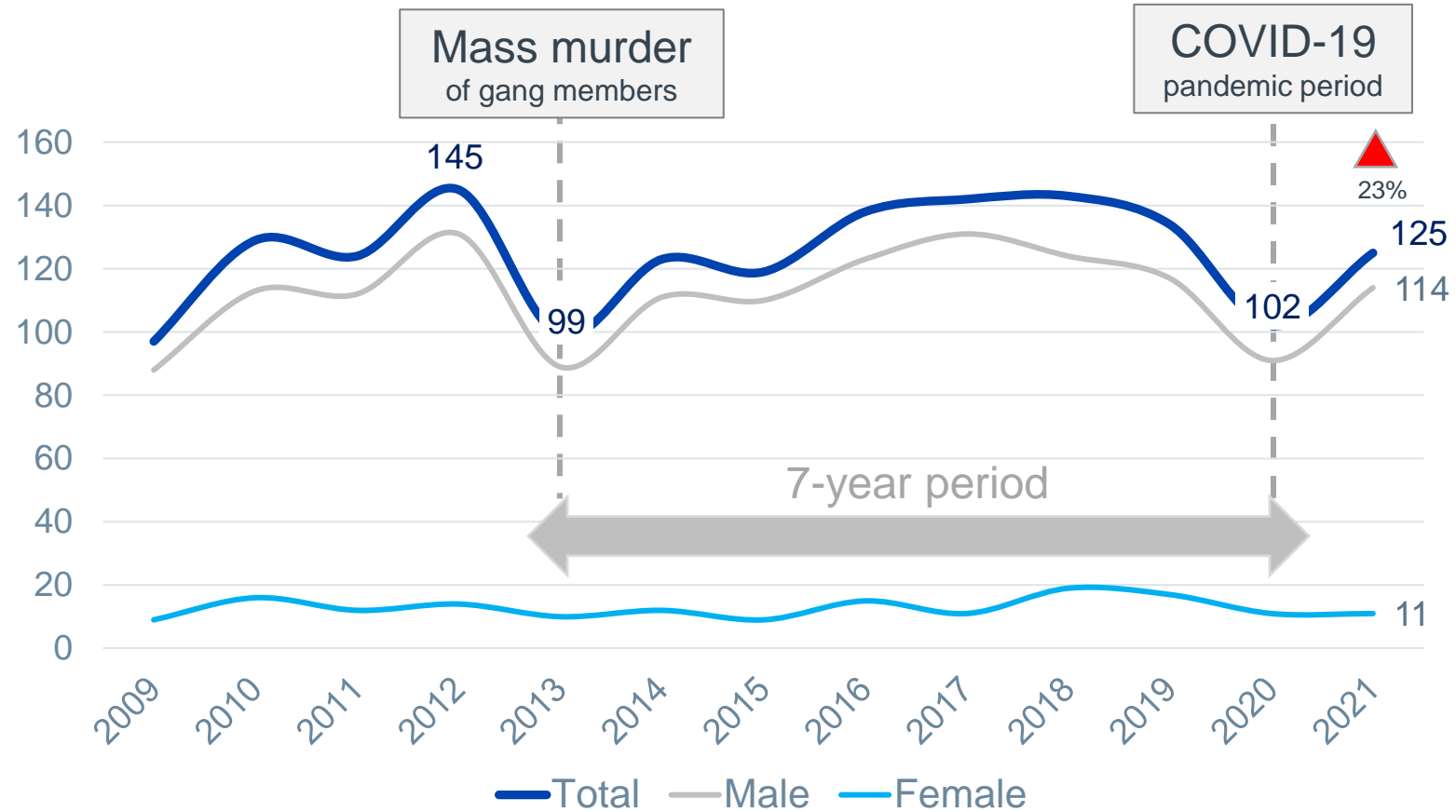
Belize's Murder Rate (2009-2021)

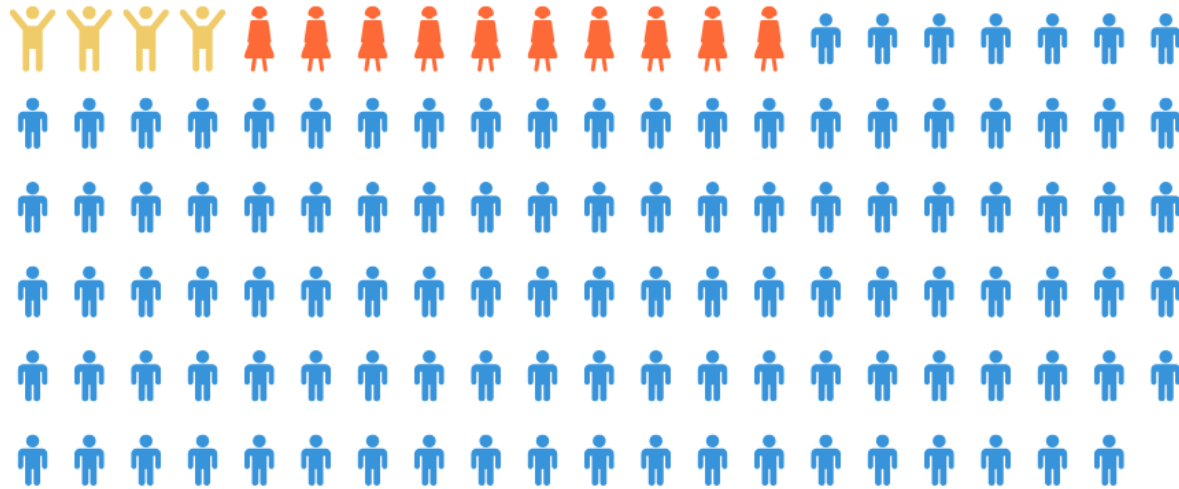
Historical and Recent Trends in Murder Incidents

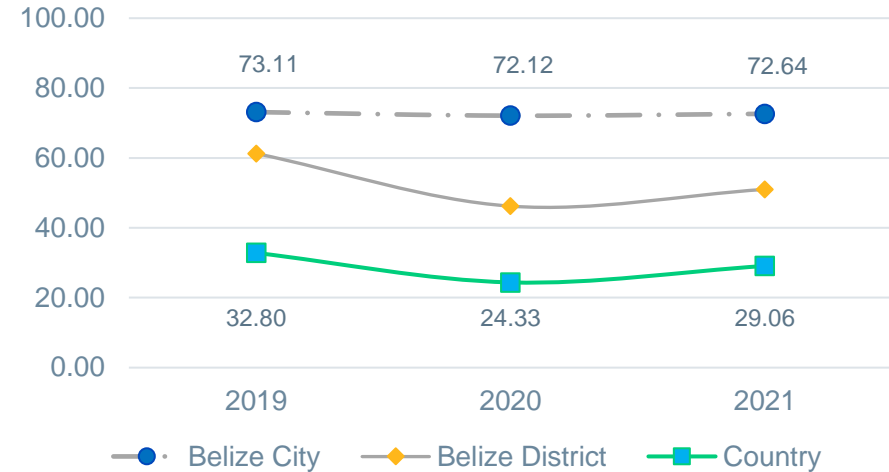
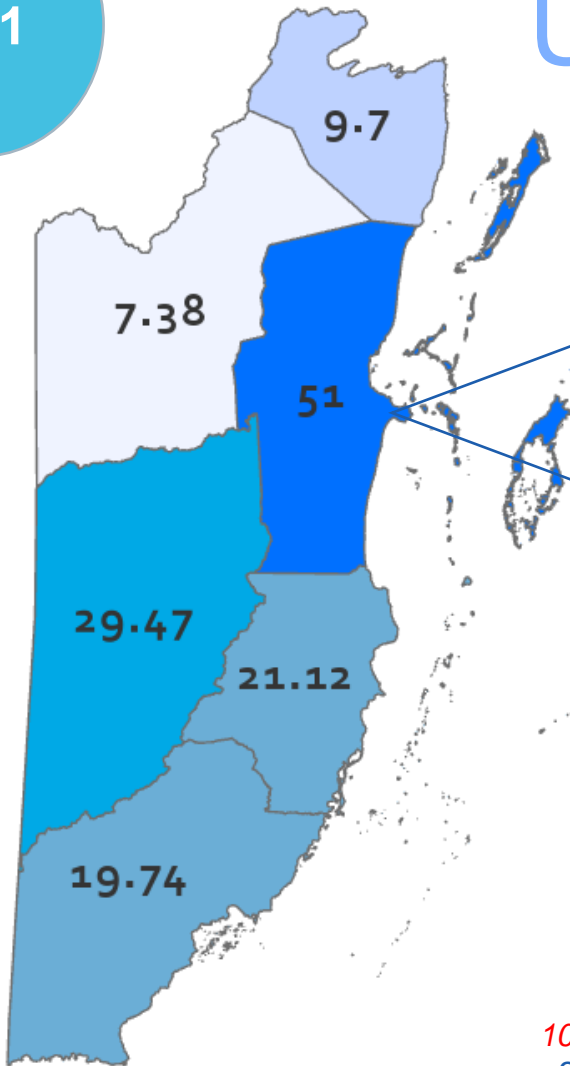

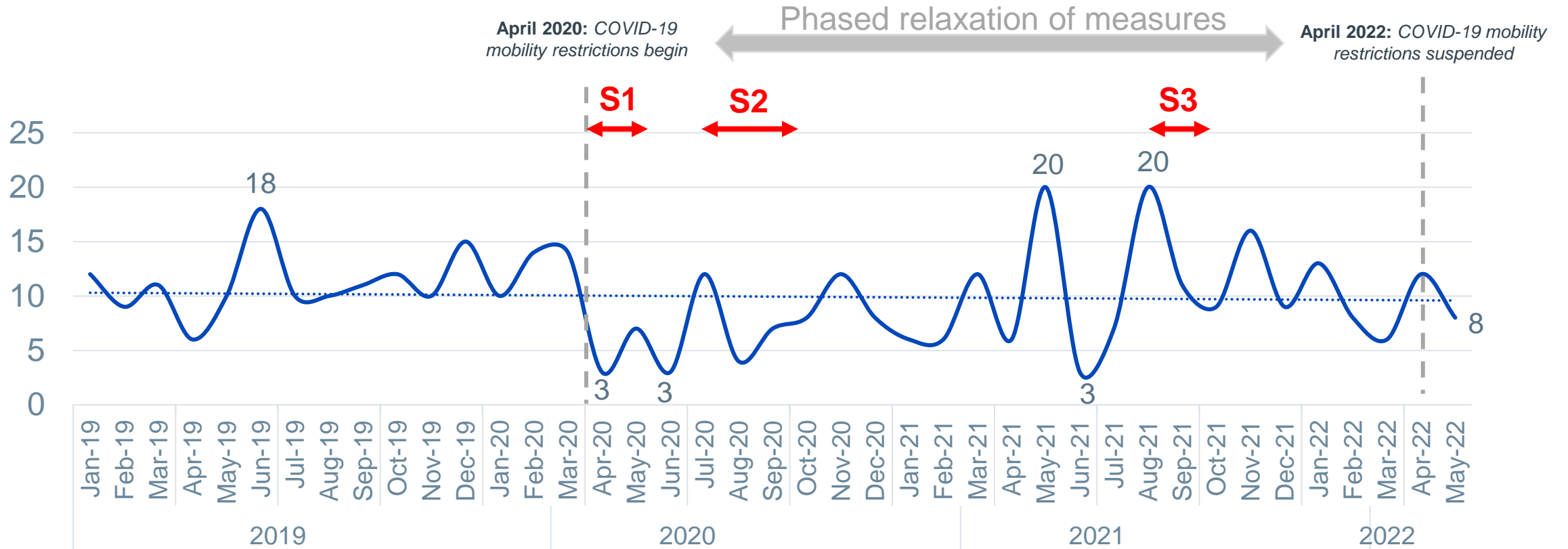
In 2018, the Belize City rate was 105.64 per 100,000, and it had declined by 31%, to 73.11 in 2019. The gains have mostly been sustained, notwithstanding the pandemic.

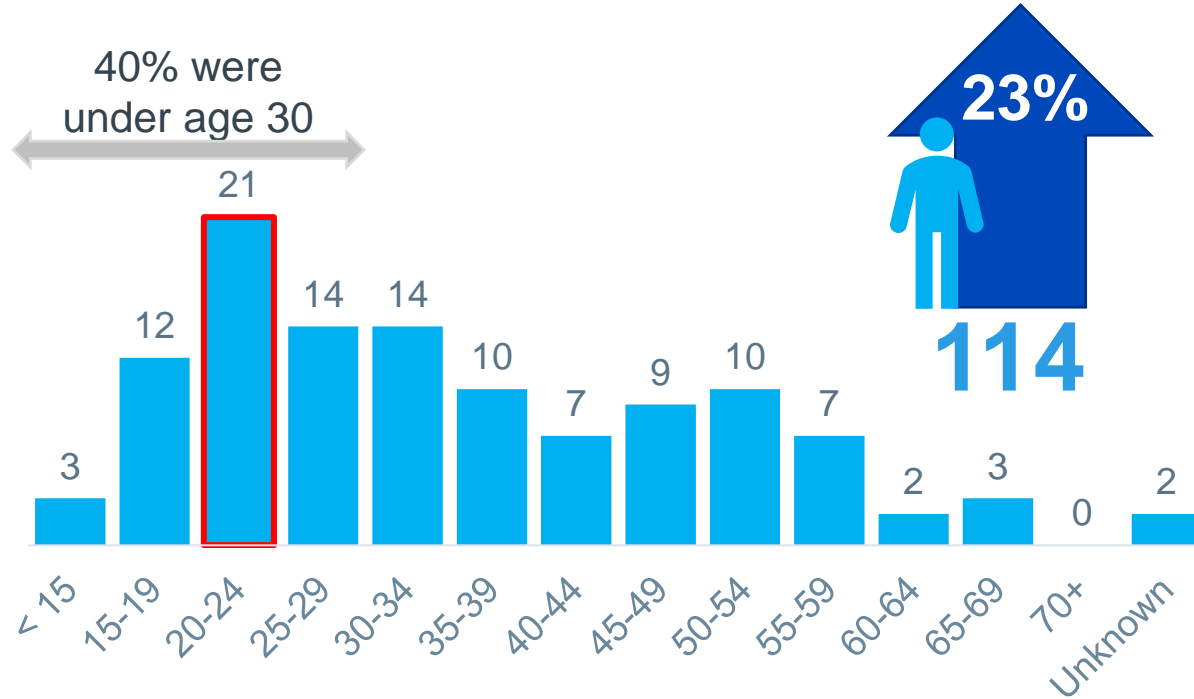
Murders per Month (Jan 2019 – May 2022)



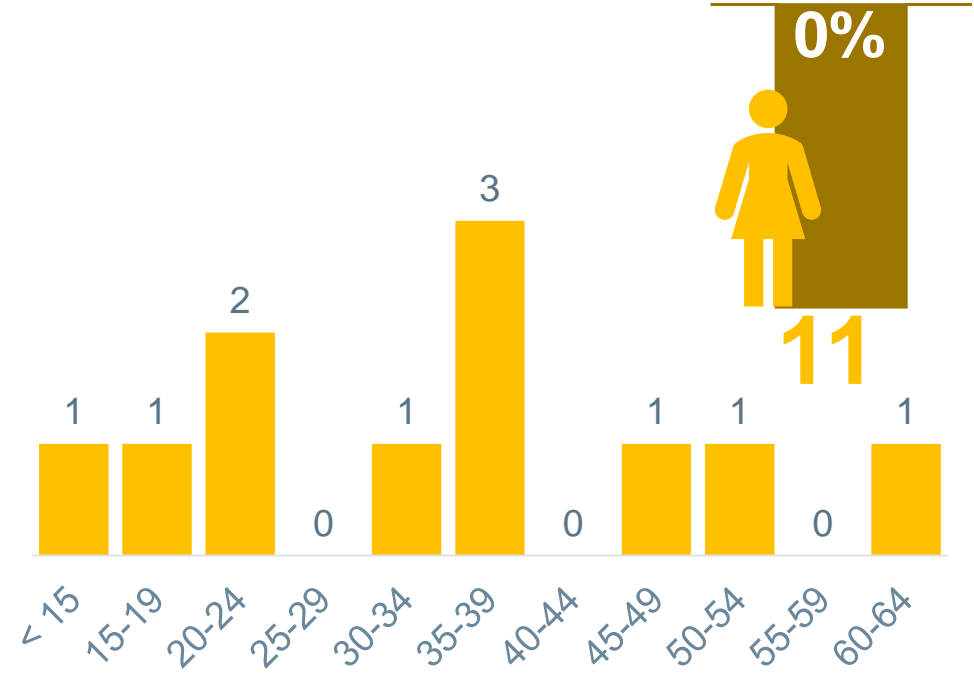

- In 2021, 64 percent of females who were murdered were victims of gender-related murders or femicides.
- 7 of these killings were in the context of double murders;
- 3 of the women were killed along with their son or daughter



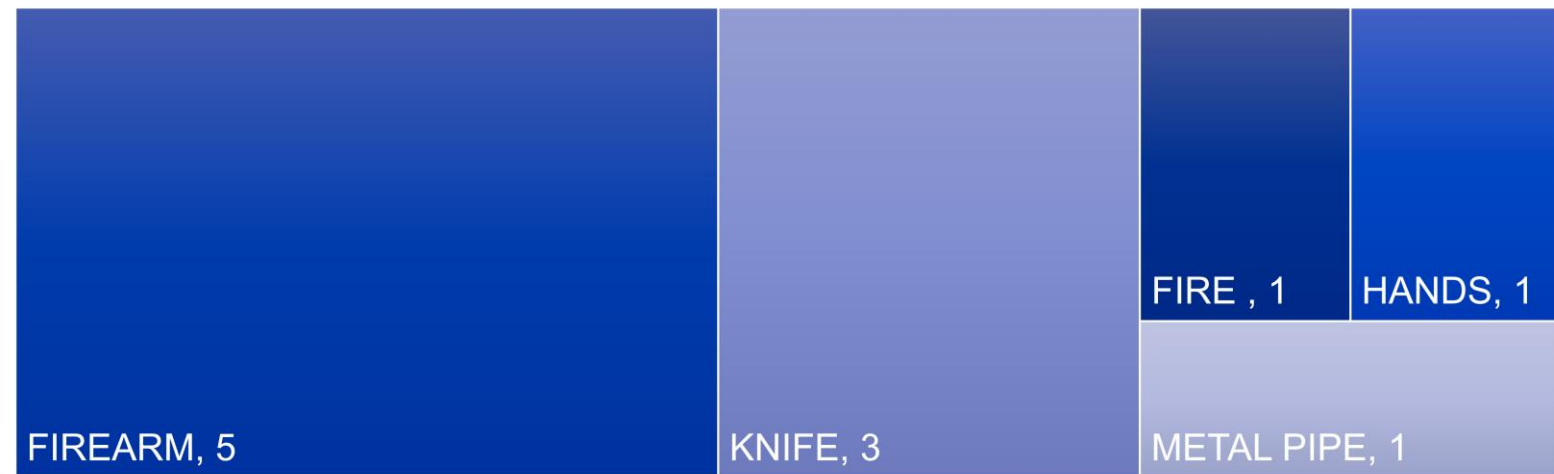

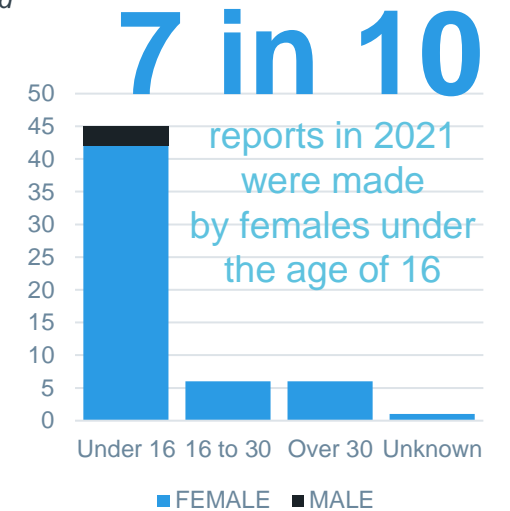
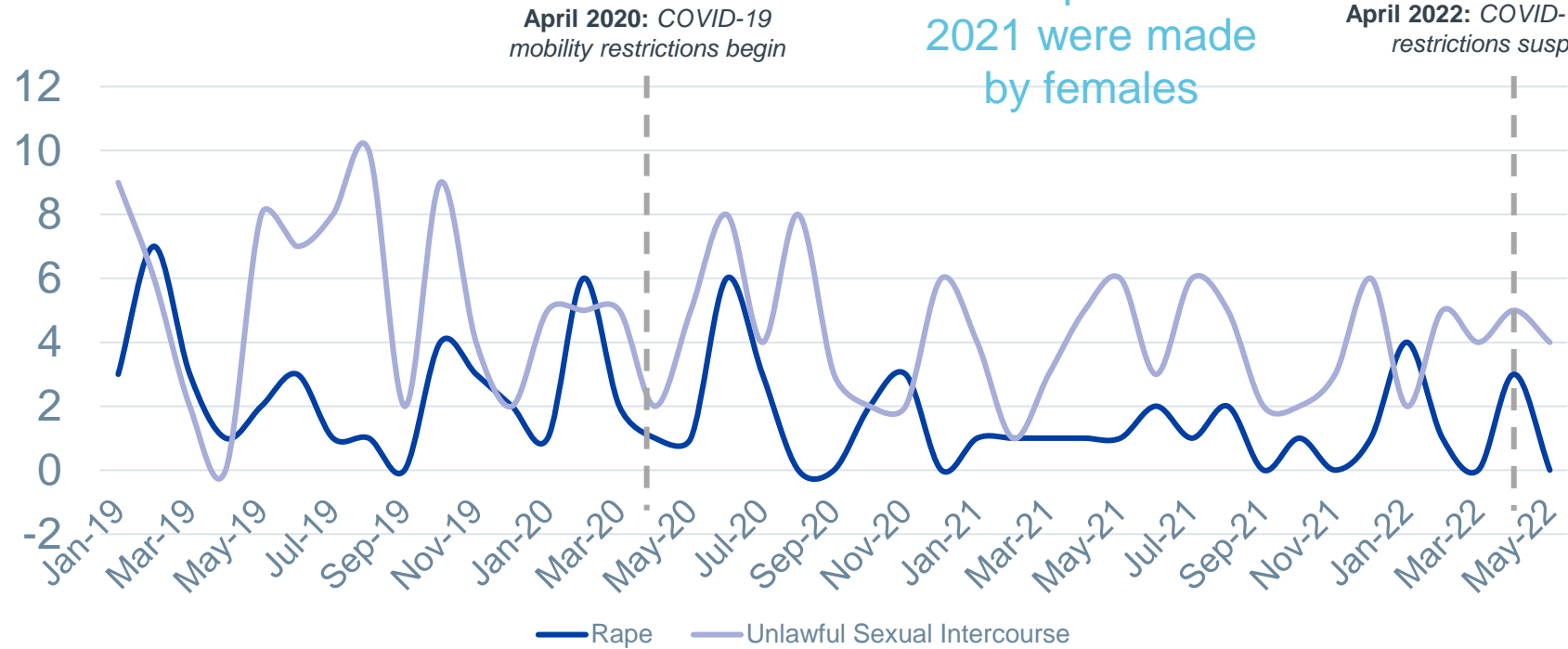
Proportionally, more females are killed with brute force of blunt and sharp objects than males were, although firearms remained the primary object used. The percentage of firearm killings of females had increased during the pandemic year, 2020.

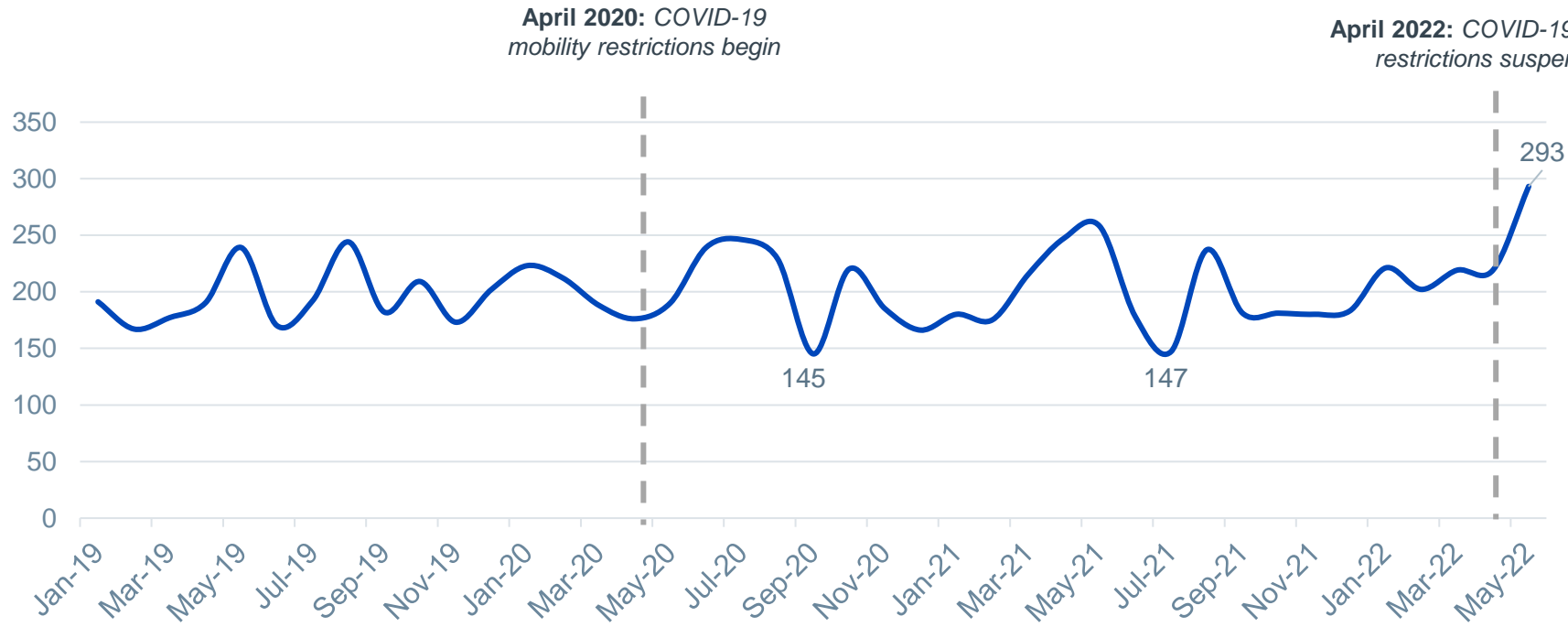

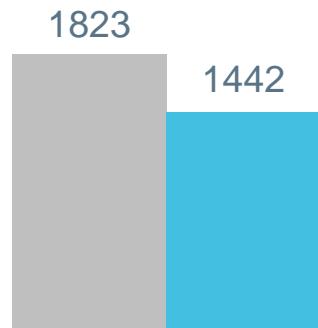

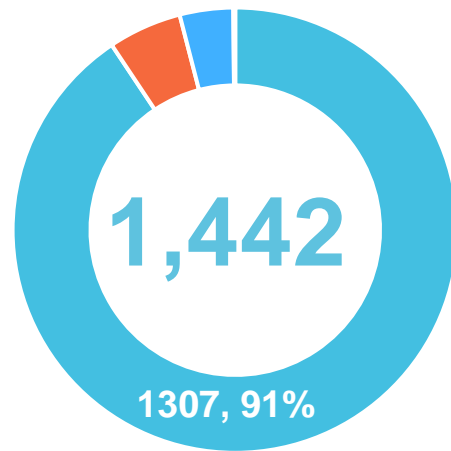

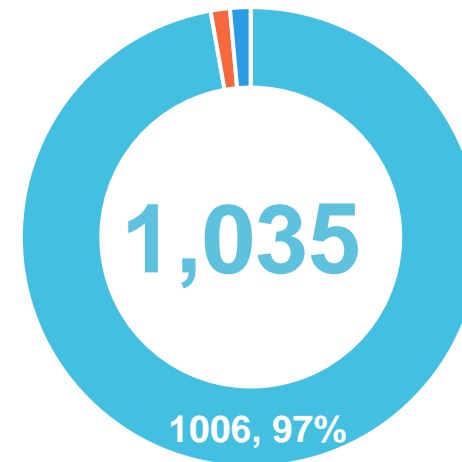

With the easing of gang-related States of Emergencies and detentions for COVID-19 related violations, there was a sharp decline in persons being sent to prison.

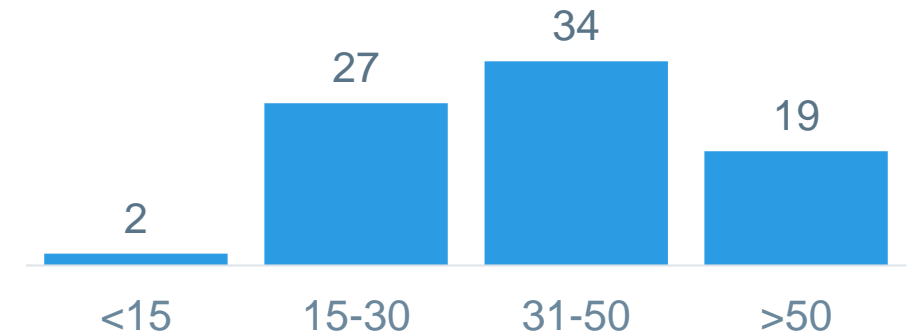
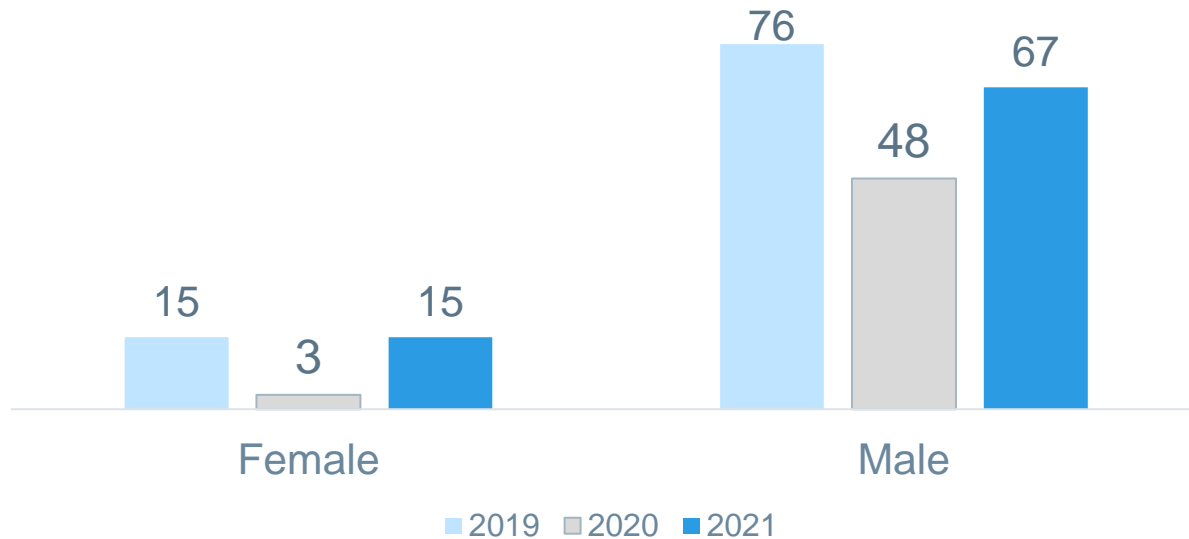
ROAD TRAFFIC FATALITIES



ROAD TRAFFIC FATALITIES

- With mobility restrictions in place during 2020, road traffic fatalities fell substantially, by 44%.
- Although these increased again in 2021 (by 61%) as Belize began to reopen, they remained below pre-pandemic levels.

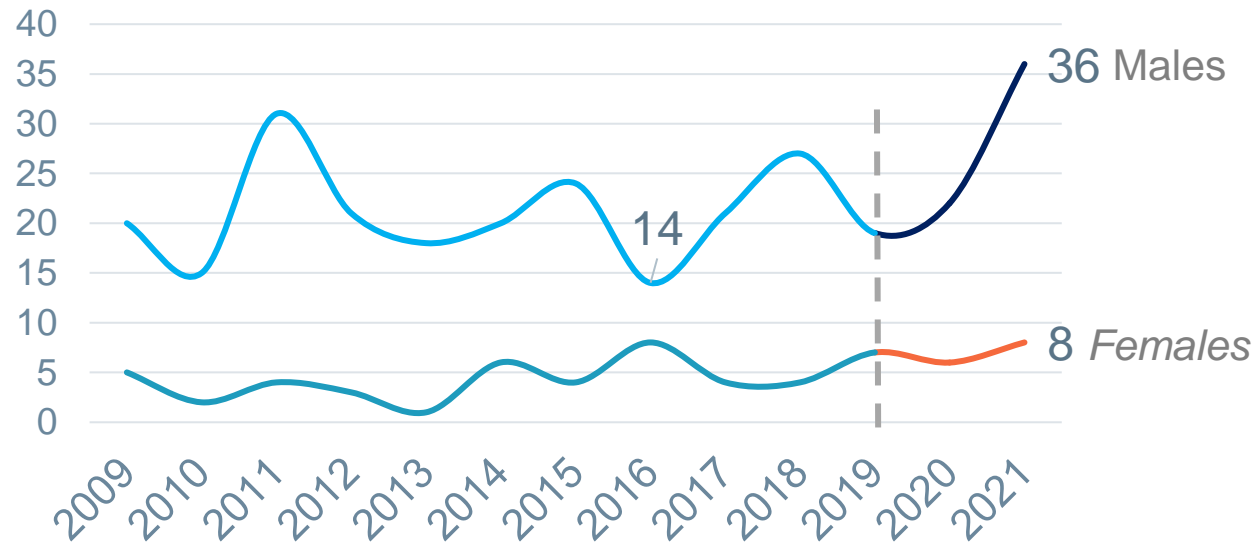

SUICIDES



SUICIDES

- In 2021, suicides reached the highest levels on record since 2009—a period of 12 years
- 2021 registered a 57 percent increase over 2020

- There were 44 suicides recorded* in 2021.
- The median age for suicide victims was 33 for males and 27 for females

21 suicides were recorded as of mid-June 2022

*Figures reported for 2021 are based on Forensic autopsies.

KEY TAKEAWAYS

- During 2021, Belize Police registered a 1% reduction in major crimes.
- The murder count increased 25%, from 102 to 125, while the rate (which had declined 26% during in 2020) increased 19% in 2021, from 24.33 to 29.06 incidents per 100,000.
- Urban violence was largely responsible for this increase, as 4 in 10 murders happened in the Belize City area.
- Males accounted for 9 in 10 murder victims, and 40% of the males murdered were below the age of 30.
- 64 percent of females who were murdered were victims of femicide, and there were occasions where their children were also killed with them.
- 96% of reports of sexual violence in the major crimes categories were made by females, and 7 in 10 were under the age of 16.



KEY TAKEAWAYS

- Domestic violence cases are on an upward trajectory. Reports are up 7% for the period January to May 2022, compared to the same time in 2021. 8 in 10 reports are made by females.
- Burglaries, which account for more than 50% of major crimes, are generally below pre-pandemic levels but are increasing. There has also been a general increase in robberies and theft.
- Incarceration declined 20% (from 1,823 to 1,442) during 2021, while the prison population declined by 7% (from 1,108 to 1,035).
- Based on autopsies conducted during 2020 & 2021, suicides increased 57% - reaching the highest annual count on record since 2009; 4 in every 5 persons were males.
- Road traffic fatalities increased 61%, with 4 in every 5 persons also being males.
