HUMAN DEVELOPMENT

This is a process of expanding the options and opportunities available to individuals and building their capacities.

CITIZEN SECURITY

This involves the possibility of protecting physical and moral integrity of individuals, individual and collective achievement, the full exercise of duties and rights and the enjoyment of individual freedoms in harmonious contexts of respect for established norms.

DEMOCRATIC GOVERNANCE

This calls for efficient institutions and an economic-political context characterized by the presence of effective public services, fair rules, as well as transparent and accountable institutions.

FOCUS ON GENDER

Equity between men and women is fundamental for the advancement of human development. Promoting gender equity by mainstreaming the gender-responsive approach involves assessing the implications that any planned action has for men and women.
