According to preliminary data, between January and June 2023, there was a reduction in all offences with regard to the same period in 2022.


Homicides exhibited a -13.7% reduction 261 fewer victims



HOMICIDES

Overall, in the first half of 2023, homicides have registered lower than the same period in 2021 and 2022.

The only exception is **June with** the highest number of homicides so far this semester.









Percentage of homicides by victim sex, January to June 2023




A high percentage of homicides are under investigation, involving both **men and women.**

The available records show that homicides have mostly been attributed to social conflict (personal problems, quarrels, domestic violence, intrafamily violence, sports fans and teams).

Deaths due to traffic accident injuries according to the type of accident:







