



## TOTAL VICTIMS OF MURDER, JANUARY - SEPTEMBER 2022 VS. 2023




### AGE GROUP AND SEX OF VICTIMS OF MURDER, JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2023






Firearms were used in 76.4% of all murders (used in 52 out of 68 cases). This is a decrease for the same period in 2022 (-2.6 percentage points). The remainder were committed with sharp weapons and blunt objects.

#### MURDERS BY DISTRICT, JANUARY - SEPTEMBER 2023



The Belize District and the Cayo District remain with the highest number of victims of murder with 41 and 12, respectively.

In four out of the six districts, there was a fall in the total number of victims of murder as compared to the same period in 2022: Belize, Cayo, Corozal, and Stann Creek; while two districts reported no change: Orange Walk and Toledo.
